
The responsibility of law enforcement, fire departments, campus security and city services to keep the public and its employees safe has never been more pressing.

The importance of acting quickly has long been a focus in officer training. Having the proper tactical tools to accomplish this must be at the forefront of all departments.

Barriers have often been the first line of defense to warn, contain and gain control of situations. While traditional barricades fulfill their purpose for non-urgent situations, there exists the need for a barricade that is more practical for instant deployment.

These barriers should be:

- Substantial enough to deter the public
- Clear enough to communicate authority
- Portable enough to store compactly in a vehicle



Heavier barricade types typically require advanced planning, as they are often stored at a central warehouse and require large flatbeds or specialized vehicles to transport. They are typically staffed with a significant crew (Barricade Detail), requiring overtime hours to deploy.



Waiting for central warehouses to deliver heavy barricades can be an hours-long waiting game. This leaves officials at the mercy of situations and unable to turn their focus to the real tasks at hand. These situations not only cost time and money but in some cases put people and property at risk.

Enter a new generation of innovative, instantly deployable, portable, and authoritative tactical barricades that meet or exceed regulations and guidelines for use.

What is a QDB Tactical Barricade?

QDBs, or Quick Deployment Barricades, are an important innovation in tactical support equipment, designed to fill a gap in the available crowd control toolbox.



QDBs are portable, quick to set up by a single person and retract to small, storable sizes. These allow every vehicle and station to have units immediately available. QDB units are extremely durable, heavy-duty barricades that require minimal maintenance. Changeable signage on the QDBs create a legal barrier with proper communication of purpose and authority that is missing from many traditional barricades.

Police, Fire and Federal agencies have all begun adopting these units. Highly-effective QDBs fold down, allowing multiple barricades to be stored in vehicles. When deployed, they create a full blockade and may interlock to create extended barrier lines. While easily lifted, the units, are extremely stable and are resistant to situational and environmental forces.





Comparison of Tactical Barricades:

STEEL BARRICADES

aka "Bicycle," "French" or "Sunshine" barricades

PROS: Heavy, intimidating, largely impenetrable.

CONS: Requires significant maintenance (rust removal, coating, re-welding). Generally stored at central warehouses, requiring large, flatbed trucks and large crews to deploy.

BEST USE: Large volume crowd control, with good, long-range planning. These offer moderate authority due to lack of color or signage relevant to agency or specific use.



PROS: Heavy, intimidating.

CONS: Short lifespan due to splintered or deteriorated wood. Significant maintenance of painting and re-constructing legs. Generally stored at central warehouses, requiring large, flatbed trucks and large crews to deploy.

BEST USE: Medium volume crowd control, with good, long-range planning. These offer moderate authority due to lack of signage relevant to specific use.

PLASTIC CONES

PROS: Light, easy to move and place.

CONS: Lower visibility, often confusing some drivers and not respected by others, resulting in cones being knocked over, run over and abused. These offer low perceived authority and generally lack authoritative identification signage. Short lifespan with inability to repair.

BEST USE: Extended traffic areas requiring re-direction. Stacks of 8-12 cones may be tossed into a vehicle for smaller deployments.







CRIME SCENE TAPE

PROS: Lightweight, authoritative when imprinted with authority identification. Moderate perceived authority.

CONS: One-time use product, requires on-site objects to act as anchor points to be used effectively. Precincts can run through miles of this tape over short periods. If not carefully removed, this tape becomes a blight on neighborhoods. Not durable, easily torn, and frequently ignored.

BEST USE: Easy to deploy where existing posts, signs, trees and other structures are available.



QDB Units:

QUICK DEPLOYMENT BARRICADES

PROS: They are light enough to set up by a single person yet solid enough to create a solid authoritative barrier as required by law. Requires low maintenance. Heavy-duty, portable and authoritative. Instantly deployable. Signage inserts identify applicable scenario (i.e. crime scenes, command posts, police line, fire line, etc.). Interlocking carabiner hooks create continuous barricade lines. High-visibility lights add safety. QDBs fold down to small spaces to allow storage in vehicle trunks.

CONS: Not for long-term installations.

BEST USE: Immediate deployment situations, filling in gaps traditional barriers such as; pop-up checkpoints, crime scenes, command posts, DWI check points, accidents, fire hose protection, street closures and more.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This study, created by interviewing established law enforcement, fire and city service professionals, shows the need for QDBs to increase safety, responsiveness and meet current legal expectations for authorities. It is vital to create and maintain barriers that protect both the public as well as the officers and authorities.

Each precinct and jurisdiction agreed they would clearly benefit by having QDB units on hand for mobile deployment. Centralized departments should also consider adding QDB storage racks, which hold up to 25 units in a 4'x4' footprint. These racks can be mounted on larger tactical vehicles or stored at stations for immediate deployment.

Low-maintenance costs, speed of deployment and increased safety more than justify any investment in these units.
